RULES AND REGULATIONS

All Announcements made during the show weekend will take precedence over any written publications.

Show Animals

- ****Entries must be postmarked no later than May 22, 2010**

- **Animals shown in the WLBA Preview Saturday Show must have a paid membership in the WJHA for 2010. This show requires a separate entry form. Contact Jill Alf at 608-868-2505 or www.wisconsinlivestockbreeders.com for a Saturday entry form. Entries due May 1st.**
- **Jackpot Show Premiums are for Steer and Heifers only.** Champion Steer and Heifer Overall \$100, Reserve Champion Overall \$75. Heifer Division \$40/Reserve Division \$30. Other awards will be given for champion bull and champion cow/calf.
- Heifers-Calved on or after September 1, 2008 with recorded ownership by June 1, 2010.
- Bulls-Bred and Owned, calved after September 1, 2008, must be bred and owned by the junior exhibitor for the WLBA Preview Show. WJHA Open Jackpot Show, bulls due not need to be bred and owned.
- Steer-Hereford steers born in 2009 and sired by a bull recorded in the register of the AHA. AHA Hereford Steer Certification papers required at check-in. Steers will be weighed and classes divided at check-in.
- Health papers and registration certificates required at check-in during cattle processing Friday or Saturday. Tattoos will be checked- missing, illegible, altered, or incorrect tattoos may result in disqualification.
- **Late Check-In on Sunday Morning with prior approval from BJ Jones, otherwise cattle to be in place by 6:00 p.m. on Saturday.**
- **No cattle are allowed to leave the fairgrounds once they are checked in for the WLBA or WJHA Jackpot show.**
- **Only the original certificate of registration will be accepted at check-in. Photocopies are not allowed. Registrations must be in the name of the exhibitor and his/her siblings only. Bulls may be co-owned by farms but must have the junior exhibitor as a current owner and sole breeder.**
- Entries must meet the state health regulations of Wisconsin and any states that are crossed. Health papers should be given at check-in.
- This is a fit show.
- If any requirements are not satisfactorily met, the Show Committee reserves the right to disqualify any entries.

General Information

- Entry Fees are \$30.00 per class (Heifers, Cow/Calf, Bulls, Steers). LATE ENTRIES are \$45.00 per class.
- **At the conclusion of the show you are requested to remove your bedding to the designated area outside the building.**
- No smoking in the barns
- Appropriate dress will be enforced in the show ring.

- Cattle will be released at the conclusion of the show.

Junior Events

- At least 7 years of age and not yet 22 as of January 1, 2010
- **Participants must pay annual WJHA dues of \$10.00 if they are taking part in any event of the WLBA Junior Preview Show.**
- Showmanship Classes during the WLBA preview show
 - Pee Wee: 7-9 Years of age as of January 1,2010
 - Junior: 10-13 Years of age as of January 1,2010
 - Intermediate: 14-17 Years of age as of January 1,2010
 - Senior: 18-21 Years of age as of January 1, 2010
- Showmanship Rules
 - Sign up for Showmanship will be at check-in
 - Classes will be divided into heats if the entries become numerous
 - Bulls cannot be shown in any showmanship classes
- Illustrated Speech Contest- Any topic pertaining to the beef Industry
 - Pee Wee- Speech length: 2-4 minutes.
 - Junior- Speech length: 3-5 minutes.
 - Intermediate- Speech length: 3-5 minutes.
 - Senior- Speech length: 6-8 minutes.
 - Winners from Junior, Intermediate and Senior Divisions will qualify as the Wisconsin representative at the NJHE. **NOTE: A minimum of one illustration or visual aid must be used. No electronic devices i.e. slides/power points will be allowed.**
- Quiz Bowl
 - A written quiz test will be offered Saturday night. High Scores from the written test will qualify for both the Junior and Senior Quiz Bowl teams at the JNHE.
- Team Marketing
